TRY THIS

Ask the stylist to demonstrate where a soft face-framing section would fall before cutting.

- 01 Bring the brief and discuss natural texture.
- 02 Ask what changes when the hair is air-dried.
- 03 Agree on the shortest front piece before the cut.

KEEP

Keep the length in this example's brief.

SKIP

Skip any suggestion that conflicts with the stated preference or causes discomfort.

UPKEEP

Use familiar tools first; discuss hair maintenance with the stylist.

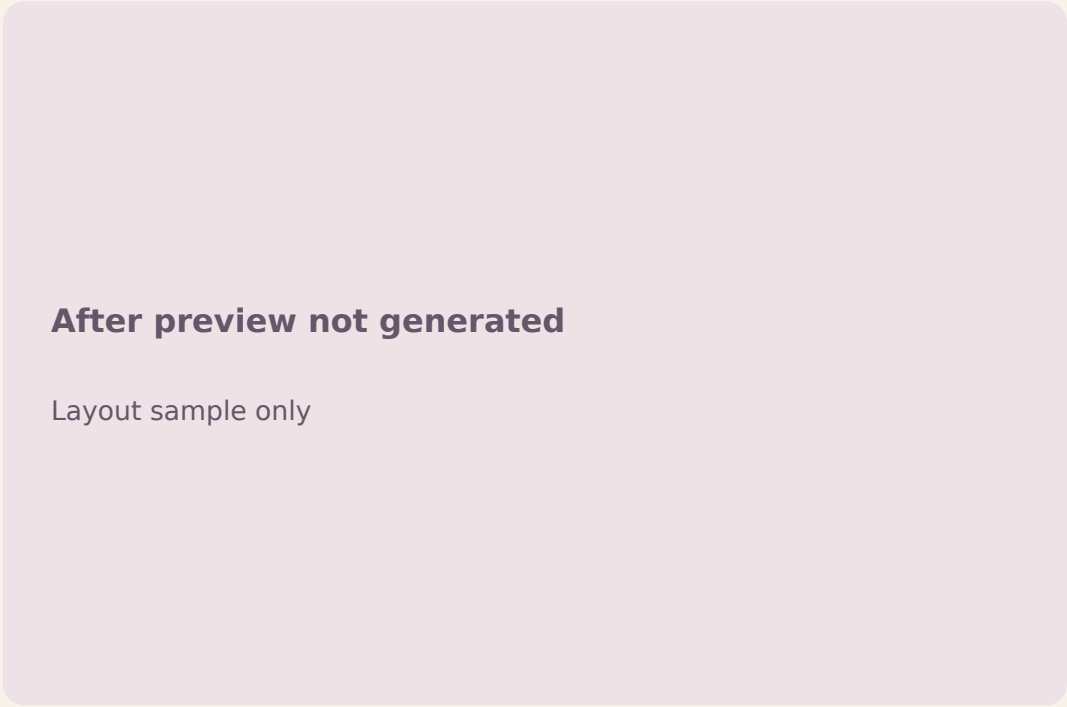

TRY THIS

Try a narrow line at the outer upper lash line, rather than a heavy band across the lid.

- 01 Start with a short section near the outer lashes.
- 02 Keep the eye relaxed when checking placement.
- 03 Remove the line gently if the effect is not preferred.

KEEP

Keep the eye shape and everyday comfort.

SKIP

Skip any suggestion that conflicts with the stated preference or causes discomfort.

UPKEEP

TRY THIS

For a defined direction, begin with the tail rather than filling the entire brow equally.

- 01 Brush the hair into its natural position.
- 02 Use small strokes only where definition is wanted.
- 03 Check both brows at normal mirror distance.

KEEP

Keep the existing brow outline.

SKIP

Skip any suggestion that conflicts with the stated preference or causes discomfort.

UPKEEP

Use familiar tools first; discuss hair maintenance with the stylist.

Try a small amount of blush on one cheek and compare the placement in daylight.

- 01 Start with a small amount of a familiar product.
- 02 Blend the outer edge before adding more.

SKIP

Skip any suggestion that conflicts with the stated preference or causes discomfort.

For subtle definition, trace the existing border lightly and soften inward.

- 01 Use a product close to the shade already preferred.
- 02 Do not extend the outline to imply a different shape.
- 03 Check the result with the rest of the makeup.

KEEP

Skip any suggestion that conflicts with the stated preference or causes discomfort.

UPKEEP

Use familiar tools first; discuss hair maintenance with the stylist.
